The board members and I have taken some art to the store on a trial basis. The owner is so happy, that he's agreed to continue to allow us to show work on a continuous basis with the goal of changing out the art every 60 days. So here's a few guidelines that everyone needs to follow.

- Original work only.
- All artwork including frames must be in good condition.
- All our work must be available for sale, and not priced so high that no one would ever consider purchasing it.
- All artwork must be family friendly, so no nudity, violence, religious or political art.
- All artwork will be approved by the owner of the store before hanging.
- There will be a 20% commission on all sales of art.
