## **GUEST SPEAKER**

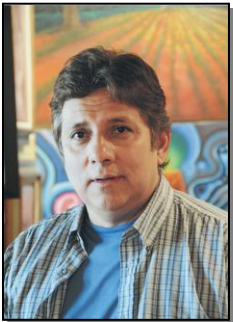
### **JIM LANE**
