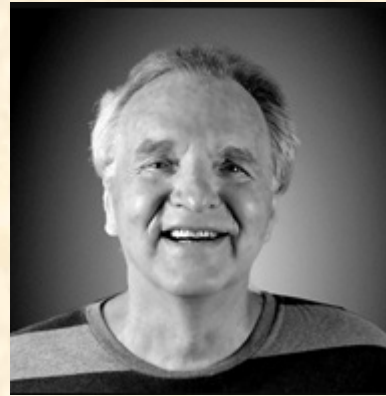

October Speaker



Manfred Peter O'Hare was born and raised in Germany. He attended undergraduate school at California State University Long Beach, and graduate school at the University of Düsseldorf, Germany, where he received a Master's Degree in Art and Art History.

Manfred's work is inspired by abstract expressionism, optical art and music. He transforms abstract ideas into three dimensions by fusing musical ideas, color theory and texture. He incorporates a wide array of materials such as glass, metal, fabric, and plastic elements to achieve a unique sense of harmony and a visual interest that engages the viewer. His art is vibrant, full of movement and whimsical, at times, with dynamic lines and colors that fascinate the viewer.

Manfred's art is in private collections throughout the USA and Europe.

Manfred currently teaches art history for the College of Southern Nevada and has worked as a docent for the Guggenheim-Hermitage Museum.

Clarification for Monthly Art Competitions

Open Competition: Members bring **one** piece of any artwork. The artwork will be categorized as one of the following:

- Jewelry – jewelry (wearable articles intended for personal adornment, not to include clothing)
- Painting & Drawing – any painting or drawing, regardless of medium
- Photography & Digital – photo prints or digital artwork is valid
- Other – this is the catch-all category. If not one of the above, it belongs in the “other” category.
- If there is only one item in a category, there will be no winner selected for that category.

THEME COMPETITIONS: THE ARTWORK MUST BE SOMEHOW RELATED TO THE CHALLENGE THEME.

IF THE ARTWORK IS NOT RELATED TO THE THEME, IT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. THE ARTWORK WILL ALSO BE CATEGORIZED IN ONE OF THE FOUR CATEGORIES.

CCAG Christmas Party

Members will be voting to decide which of the following two options they would choose for our Christmas party this December. Since both of our options cost over \$500, a membership vote is required to approve the expenditure as per our CCAG by-laws. The vote will take place at our regular meeting on Tuesday, October 15.

The projected date for the Christmas party is Saturday, December 7. In the event that the date has already been booked by our chosen venue, another date in December may be selected. Each member can bring one guest.

Important: We need member volunteers to serve on a committee to help, especially for Option 1.

Option 1

Location: Mountain Crest Community Center, 4701 N. Durango, Las Vegas, NV 89129 – This venue is in Mountain Crest Park. Major cross streets are Lone Mountain and N. Durango.

Food: Turkey and ham provided by CCAG.

All other food provided by members. Members would sign up to bring a dish.

Drinks: Water and soft drinks provided by CCAG.

Wine provided by CCAG (if we are able to obtain a permit to serve wine there). Mountain Crest is part of the Clark County Parks system, and a permit to serve alcohol in the building is required.

If a permit is not given, no alcoholic beverages will be available.

Serving Dishes, Plates, Utensils, Tablecloths, Napkins – CCAG would need to provide these.

Room Set-up and Clean-up – CCAG would need to set up before the party and clean up afterwards.

Estimated cost: \$630 (paid by CCAG)

Option 2

Location: Durango Hills Golf Club, 3501 N Durango Dr, Las Vegas, 89129. This venue is a private room in the restaurant at Durango Hills. Major cross streets are N. Durango and Cheyenne (it is north of Cheyenne).

Food: Hors d'oeuvres provided by Durango Hills: chicken tenders, vegetarian spring rolls, seasonal fresh fruit, and jumbo shrimp cocktail with cocktail sauce

Drinks: available from Durango Hills bar; members and their guests would pay for their own drinks

Serving Dishes, Plates, Utensils, Tablecloths, Napkins – provided by Durango Hills

Room Set-up and Clean-up – provided by Durango Hills

Estimated cost: \$1200 (paid by CCAG)
